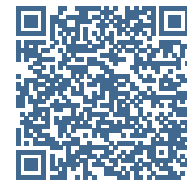

OVERVIEW

Calling all Surgical SHO's in Ireland enrolled on our RCSI CPD Support Scheme 2024-25

Register your interest today for our flexible RCSI Basic Surgical Principles and Practice Certificate which is 80% online with the majority of sessions delivered in the evenings to suit the busy schedules of Surgical SHO's in Ireland.

The Basic Surgical Principles and Practice Certificate is a one-year programme delivered between September 2024 and June 2025. This programme will utilise a blended approach to teaching. Teaching resources will be housed on the Moodle platform. Technical skills training will be delivered face to face on campus for two full days. The online sessions will be live (synchronous) with faculty present in the class. Pre-course reading and post-course exercises will be required to be undertaken on top of attending online classes.

CONTENT

The programme covers the broad areas of:

1. Core Knowledge and Clinical Judgement
2. Clinical Skills
3. Technical skills
4. Non-Technical Skills
5. Professionalism and Patient Safety

80% completion of this programme equates to 50 CPD points

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered eligible for the programme, you must be:

1. Registered on Continuous Professional Development Support Scheme (CPD_SS)
2. Work within the Public Health Service
3. Surgical SHO

WELLBEING SUPPORTS

This course also includes a live online session titled "Caring for Yourself in Surgery," featuring lecture-led tips and studies to help surgeons maintain their musculoskeletal health.

This program also offers participants the opportunity to book an online coaching session with a qualified coach to help doctors enhance performance and set goals.

FEES

The cost of this programme is €2,240, all of which are covered through the training funds that are available to NCHD's from the HSE.

- » The first €990 is covered via the NCHD CPD funding which we will claim directly from the HSE on behalf of the NCHD'S so that there is no out of pocket costs.
- » Candidates will need to pay the remaining balance of €1,250 which can be paid in three instalments. NCHDs can claim the €1,250 fee back directly from their hospitals as this certificate is approved by HSE NDTP under the Training Support Scheme (TSS). The full €1250 can be claimed back through the TSS scheme.
